# Are you new to Surf Life Saving?

Anyone joining Maranui Surf Lifesaving Club must register with <u>Surf Life Saving New Zealand.</u>
All members need to be registered on the SLSNZ portal so we can enter athletes for carnivals and courses.

There is no cost to do this, and you only ever do this **once** per child/person. Every member receives a unique SLSNZ number.

Please Note: We are unable to enter athletes into carnivals if they are not registered via the SLSNZ portal.
